  Twenty-seven students were assessed; in the Spring Summer 2006 to Spring Summer 2009 timeframe, there have been 44 enrollments and 29 completions.

  The 27 students were randomly selected from the 29 students who completed the course in the Spring Summer 2007 to Spring Summer 2009 period, using information available in the online course sites.

This is the first formal assessment of this course; however, the course assessment tools have had ongoing modification in response to student and instructor identification of problematic test questions.

Prior course documentation did not identify course outcomes or assessment plan, so we took the opportunity to create these and test their effectiveness to determine if we were in line with our plan. Outcomes as stated are:

Based on assessment of the data from the test questions and scores, students demonstrated a clear ability to identify the activities performed in managing a construction project as well as identifying strategies for managing employee interaction. The few problematic questions that were identified will be reviewed for clarity.

For both outcomes, we identified the standard of success to be 80% of students with 85% correct response.

- 1. Identify the activities performed in managing a construction project.

  Twenty-seven of the twenty-seven students assessed (100%) provided at least 85% correct responses to the assessment questions. There was a 96% correct response.
- 2. Identify strategies for managing employee interaction.

  Twenty-seven of the twenty-seven students assessed (100%) provided at least 85% correct responses to the assessment questions. There was a 97% correct response.
- 5. Describe the areas of strength and weakness in students' achievement of the learning outcomes shown in assessment results.

Strengths:

Students exceeded the standard of success that was used for this assessment, confirming that

the UAS 222 course assessments (tests and exams) are appropriately aligned with the

objectives and course content.

Weaknesses:

Students scored somewhat lower in the tests that evaluated material presented in the course textbook. The concepts presented in the textbook are not reinforced by the video lectures.

The course is being revitalized and a course textbook has been identified for use beginning Winter 2010. The new course will contain publisher content that utilizes interactive learning activities, allowing the students to engage more closely with the content of the course.
